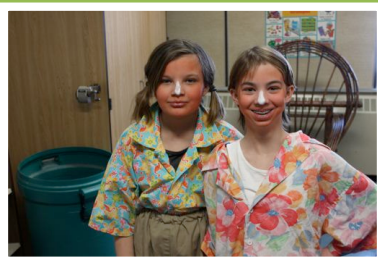

VARIANCE POLICY REMINDER

Children who attend Baldonnel School but live outside of our school catchment area must be granted a variance for three consecutive years in order to be considered a permanent student. A short letter reminding these families they are on variance will be sent out later this month.
